# **CONTEST GUIDELINES\*\***

Any artistic medium may be submitted... the only restriction is that an "avocado" must be *easily identifiable* in all pieces.

### 2-Dimensional & Photography

Artwork should be no larger than 24-inches on any side, including frame, and weigh no more than 10 lbs. Unframed paintings on canvas are required to be finished on all sides with no staples showing. Wire hangers only, with ends wrapped for safety.

(Please no sawtooth hangers.)

#### 3-Dimensional

Work should be no larger than 24" high x 18" wide, weigh no more than 20lbs., and must have a stable base when set on a flat surface.

#### **ENTRY RULES**

Artists may enter up to two (2) pieces.

The back of each piece of art must have artist's name, contact information, title of artwork and medium. Artwork must hang the entire show and may not be removed.

Artwork shown in previous shows cannot be entered.

#### **SALES**

Sales will be between the Buyer & Artist by means of a written"Purchase Agreement." Fallbrook Chamber of Commerce will not retain a commission on any sale.
